

LETTERS OF INVITATION 2009

Because of the difficulties some visitors have experienced in obtaining Visas to the United Kingdom, and to help the National Honey Show to help you, we ask that you conform STRICTLY to the following procedure:

Letters of Invitation will only be supplied for members of beekeeping, farming or rural development associations, unless in exceptional circumstances. Please, when asking for a Letter of Invitation, tell us to which association you belong.

Because only original copies are valid, Letters of Invitation **will only be sent by air-mail**, both to the potential visitor and to the British High Commission or Embassy. **None will be sent by fax or email.**

The National Honey Show cannot make hotel or hostel reservation for you. If you so request, we will supply suggestions for accommodation in London, but you are entirely responsible for making your reservation.

The National Honey Show advises that you do not confirm your travel arrangements until you have received your Visa to enter the United Kingdom.

All requests for Letters of Invitation must be received by the Assistant Secretary, Mr Malcolm Haynes, 98 Gatley Road, Gatley, Stockport, Cheshire SK8 4AB, UK or www.honeyshow.co.uk/contacts-malcolm-haynes.shtml by 30th September 2009. After that date, no further Letters will be given.

When asking for a Letter of Invitation, please ensure that all those to be invited are listed, that their names are given in full and are correctly spelt. No further names may be added at a later date. Only one such Letter will be sent.

Please give the full postal address to which the Letter of Invitation is to be sent, and the full postal address of the British High Commission or Embassy, to which a copy of the letter will be sent.

It is most important that you follow the guidance given in this notice; otherwise we will be unable to help you.
