**No. 1. Award – Second Prize.**

**Taking and hiving a swarm.**

An illustrated talk consisting of 19 images with accompanying brief lecture notes. Unfortunately, these are just “notes” or “prompts” and they do not make an accompanying dialogue for the show. The idea is for a written, or recorded, commentary to run together with the slides giving a complete presentation. However, the slides are well presented illustrating the progress of taking a swarm in a logical sequence. Work on a commentary that flows from one slide to the next. Well done.

An illustrated talk of 19 images accompanied by a written commentary. The images complement the dialogue as it flows telling the story. **No. 4 Untitled.**

A set of 12 slides unaccompanied by a commentary. Viewing the images the story proceeds for taking a swarm and each slide has a title. However the purpose of slides number 4 and 5 did not appear to be relevant in context to the story of taking a swarm as no relationship was found in their content, A written dialogue may have explained their being. The idea of the class is for an illustrated talk of slides and commentary as a complete presentation. Please develop your presentation as the material is there.
