General Fund

Endowment Fund

Hamlin Prize Memorial Fund

This fund started out as the "Endowment Fund" in 1933 with a target of £2,000, the objective being for the income to be sufficient to pay the prize money. The name of the fund was changed to the Hamlin Memorial Fund in 1957, with its object remaining the same. The name has been retained in memory of Mr Hamlin, but it has been decided to combine it with the Prize Fund



Giftaid it

Using Gift Aid for your donations means that The National Honey Show can claim back 25p from HMRC for every £1 that you give.

I am a UK taxpayer and would like the National Honey Show (NHS) to treat all donations I pay from the date of this declaration until I notify you otherwise as Gift Aid donations.

I confirm that I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6th April to 5th April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the Charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that I donate to will reclaim on my gifts for that tax year.

I understand that other taxes such as VAT or Council Tax do not qualify.

I understand that the Charity will reclaim 25p on every £1 that I give.
